

PRESS RELEASE

Recruitment to the posts of SCT Police Constable (Civil) (Men & Women)-3216 Posts, SCT Police Constable (AR) (Men & Women)- 1067 Posts, in Police Department and Warders (Male)-240 Posts & Warders (Female)- 25 Posts, in Prisons & Correctional Services Department was notified vide Notification Rc.No.202/R&T/Rect.2/2016, dt: 22-07-2016.

2. A number of requests have been received by SLPRB from candidates who were disqualified in Physical Measurement Test (PMT) for the post of Police Constable (Civil) (Men & Women) & Warder (Male & Female) at various places which started from 01-12-2016 and will be completed on 24-12-2016 except Kakinada. The main contention of the candidates is that they were not aware of the fact that they can file appeal against disqualification in Physical Measurement Test (PMT). All efforts were made to explain to candidates about appeal against disqualification in Physical Measurement Test (PMT) through press notes and display near place of Physical Measurement Test (PMT).

3. However, in view of the fact that these candidates have not qualified for Physical Measurement Test (PMT) /Physical Efficiency Test (PET) after writing Preliminary Qualifying Written Test, permission is granted to all such candidates who were disqualified in Physical Measurement Test (PMT) for the post of Police Constable (Civil) (Men & Women) & Warder (Male & Female), but couldn't file appeal, to file appeal and appear in Physical Measurement Test (PMT). In case, they qualify in Physical Measurement Test (PMT), they will have to participate in Physical Efficiency Test (PET) on the same day and submit certificates for verification. This appeal will be conducted at the following 4 places:-

1. Visakhapatnam for candidates who were issued Call Letters for Physical Measurement Test/ Physical Efficiency Test at Visakhapatnam, Vizianagaram & Srikakulam.
2. Eluru for candidates who were issued Call Letters for Physical Measurement Test/ Physical Efficiency Test at West Godavari District & Krishna district.
3. Guntur for candidates who were issued Call Letters for Physical Measurement Test/ Physical Efficiency Test at Guntur, Ongole & Nellore.
4. Kurnool for candidates who were issued Call Letters for Physical Measurement Test/ Physical Efficiency Test at Kurnool, YSR Kadapa District, Anantapuramu & Chittoor

4. As events at Kakinada are still going on and will continue upto 31.12.2016, candidates who were given Call Letter for Physical Measurement Test (PMT)/Physical Efficiency Test (PET) at Kakinada may approach Superintendent of Police, East Godavari and file appeal on any day before 31.12.2016.

5. Candidates may report for appeal on 26th, 27th or 28th December, 2016 between 6.00 AM and 12 noon along with Hall ticket, Original certificates and Xerox copies of the said certificates duly attested by the Gazetted Officer, Aadhar Card or any other ID proof.

6. Those candidates who already filed appeal after failing in Physical Measurement Test (PMT) and were disqualified in appeal in Physical Measurement Test (PMT) are not permitted to file second appeal. Also, provision of appeal is only for Physical Measurement Test (PMT). No appeal or second chance is given for Physical Efficiency Test (PET) events.

7. SLPRB AP would like to clarify to all the candidates that required specifications for Physical Measurement Test (PMT), height and chest for men and height and weight for women are clearly specified in Notification. It is the responsibility of the candidate to ensure that he/she satisfies the requirements of Physical Measurement Test (PMT). The test conducted for a particular post is limited to the purpose of Qualifying or Not Qualifying a candidate for that post. It is not a record of actual measurement of candidate which can be used for test in any other post. That is the reason why Physical Measurement Test (PMT) data is recorded afresh for all tests. The system of filing appeal on disqualification in Physical Measurement Test (PMT) is put in place for this specific purpose only.
