

PRESS RELEASE

Recruitment to the posts of SCT Police Constables (Mechanics)-25 Posts & SCT Police Constables (Drivers)-134 for Men in the Police Transport Organization was notified vide Notification Rc.No.247/R&T/Rect.2/2016, dt: 13-09-2016.

2. 6176 Hall Tickets were issued for Final Written Examination for the post of SCT PC (Driver), out of which, 5876 candidates attended and 300 candidates were absent.
3. 1096 Hall Tickets were issued for Final Written Examination for the post of SCT PC (Mechanic), out of which, 1008 candidates attended and 88 candidates were absent.
4. The Final Written Examination for the above Two Posts i.e., SCT PC(Driver) and SCT PC(Mechanics) was held on 19-2-2017 in the Morning Session & Afternoon Session respectively.
5. Out of 5876 candidates, 5472 have qualified for the post of SCT PC(Driver) in the Final Written Examination and balance are disqualified.
6. Out of 1008 candidates, 842 have qualified for the post of SCT PC(Mechanic) in the Final Written Examination and balance are disqualified.
7. Two Merit lists i.e., one for the post of SCT PC(Driver) and another for the post of SCT PC(Mechanic) including Regd.No., Date of Birth, Gender, Community, Non Creamy Layer, Ex-Servicemen, NCC, CPP, Home Guard, Local status, Final Written Examination Marks are put up on the website.
8. The information in these fields has been prepared based on certificates submitted by the candidates at the time of PMT/PET, in the Merit List.
9. In the Merit List, names of 59 candidates who were provisionally selected for the post of SCT SI(Civil)(Men & Women), SCT RSI(AR)(Men & Women), SCT RSI(SAR CPL & APSP) (Men) and for the post of SCT PC(Civil/AR)(Men & Women) & Warder (Men & Women), and who gave their consent in writing not to be considered for the post of PC(Driver) & PC (Mechanic) have been deleted.
10. Selection Lists for the 2 posts has been prepared as per Rules of Reservation and Vacancies notified.
11. As stated in Notification, for candidates claiming benefit under NCC, first preference is given to candidates having NCC-C certificate. Only, if such candidates are not available or available candidates are already allotted, then second preference is given to candidates with NCC-B Certificates. Finally, candidates with NCC-A certificates are given third preference. This Order of preference for NCC candidates is followed irrespective of their position in Merit list. Eg.: a candidate with NCC-C Certificate with lower marks is preferred over a candidate with NCC-B or NCC-A certificate with higher marks.

12. The breakup of 134 vacancies for the post of PC Driver is as under:-
