State Level Police Recruitment Board, Andhra Pradesh has issued several Notifications for conducting Recruitment for various posts. After completion of Final Written Tests, results and selection lists are being declared. Following are the results.

2. **In this regard, a number of candidates are approaching Board for submitting their certificates either through e-mail or through post.** It is to inform all candidates that **Certificate Verification** work was undertaken along with PMT/PET test for all the posts mentioned above and as per Notification, Candidates were informed in very clear terms that they must submit all relevant certificates in Original along with Xerox copy before the authorities on the day of PMT/PET. This is equally important for those candidates who intend to claim **benefit of Reservation** under Social Categories and any of the Special Categories. As already informed in Notification, the benefit of Reservation under Social Category is available only to Locals of Andhra Pradesh. The details are already mentioned in Notification which is available both in English & Telugu in Website. The candidates must submit relevant certificates to establish his nativity.

3. Further, **for BC candidates, it is necessary** to submit **NON-CREAMY LAYER Certificate to avail benefit of Reservation for Job.** All such certificates have to be submitted by candidates at the place/District Police Office where PMT/PET was conducted for them. The Board does not accept direct submission of certificates either through post or e-mail and it relies totally upon the information provided by District Police Units in establishing such facts. Candidates are once again requested to approach District Police Office in any issue related to certificates before declaration of results. Further, if any certificate was not submitted at the time of Physical Measurement Test (PMT)/Physical Efficiency Test(PET), it will be presumed that Candidate is not eligible to claim benefit under that category and only if District Supdt. of Police/DIG of Police is convince about reasons for delay in submitting Certificate, he may accept it. However, under no circumstances, any such certificate will be accepted after declaration of Results.
